# The Process of Welcoming New Members

As part of Vintage efforts to improve the way we welcome new players to the league, Larry Kubo surveyed a cross-section of club members about the idea of assigning sponsors to new players for orientation purposes. While reception for the idea was generally positive, most club members felt that though sponsor assignment would benefit players with little or no playing experience, it would be less useful to experienced players except for help on Vintage-specific playing rules and a few miscellaneous topics. Reason: it's widely held that most teammates and Vintage members go out of their way to help new players get up to speed --- we are a friendly group.

To address this wide range of experience levels while also ensuring every new player is welcomed to Vintage, Larry proposed that managers be required to assign a sponsor from their team to each new player to offer advice and assistance as needed. Larry also suggested that we post a guide and information for all new players on the Vintage

website, which he volunteered to organize and write. Larry will administer the program until it is up and running. The Board accepted Larry's proposal.

### **Investment Options**

At present we are receiving a pitifully small return on our club investments. Morgan Stanley has agreed to present options to us that will protect our principal while earning us a return greater than that from a bank.

## **Corporate Matters**

We are still in the process of getting the Club compliant with the state and are looking at becoming a 501(c) charitable organization. We are in the process of obtaining old financial records so that we can proceed with this initiative.
