There were no new members this month.

President's Comments:

A lot is happening in Vintage. Sign-ups are being taken for 2016 dues and for the annual Holiday Party. Details for both can be found on our website at www.seniorsoftballsanjose.com. The Party is five weeks away and will be a great place to spend an evening with your fellow club members and their guests.

The annual election is underway with all positions up for re-election along with our annual awards. We also will be voting on our new bylaws which are being revised in accordance with state requirements for non-profits. The complete revised bylaws document can be read on our website. As I have previously mentioned, the new bylaws will not alter the structure, organization, or operation of the Club.

Our next meeting on November 3 will be a combined general membership meeting. We are doing this to enable anyone with questions related to the bylaws or other matters to

bring their question to the board. As I have said in the past, please bring up any question or concern related to the Club to any board member at any time. It is not necessary to wait for a general membership meeting if you have a proposal or question.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

The Board approved the September Board minutes which are posted on our website.

Treasurer's Report:

The board reviewed the financial performance for the month of September and year to date. September 30 is our fiscal year end and we ended the year in excellent shape with over \$31,000 in cash reserves. While we do anticipate increased expenses in 2016 the Club remains adequately funded.

Rules Committee Updates:

Hit runner- If the runner is hit with a fair batted ball while touching a base, he is not out. If the nearest defensive player is in front of the base runner who was hit, the ball is live. Since the ball is live the defense is free to make whatever plays are available.

If the defensive player is behind the base runner, the ball is ruled dead, the hitter is awarded a base hit and runners are advanced ONLY if forced to advance.

If the runner is hit by the ball while off base and before it passes an infielder, the ball is dead and the hit runner is out. The batter is awarded first base.

Foul Tips-A foul ball caught by the catcher must go higher than the batter's head to be declared an out.

Mercy Rule- If a team is ahead by 15 or more runs after five innings have been completed, or four and 1/2 innings with the home team ahead, the game shall be declared a complete game. If the visiting team goes ahead by 15 or more runs in the 6th, 7th, or extra innings, play continues until the home team has its half of the inning to close within 15 runs.

Approval of fiscal 2016 budget

The board approved the budget for fiscal year 2016 which assumes income of \$19,000 consisting primarily of dues.

Defibrillators:

The Club has a defibrillator at DeAnza and Hamann Fields. We are investigating the cost of purchasing a third defibrillator for Mise Field. We also feel it is necessary for players to be familiar with their use and will be looking at ways to get certain members trained to operated them. This may be through a video presentation to managers or some other method.

It is also necessary to periodically check the defibrillator to ensure the battery is still charged and the devise is properly operating.

The Tuesday/Thursday draft will take place on October 22. Jack will notify managers of the location. The Saturday draft will take place on October 31 at Lou's office.
