President's Comments:

Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

The Board approved the June Board of Director meeting minutes which are posted on our website.

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's report was presented and approved. Our financial condition remains strong and we anticipate ending up our fiscal year at a break even or slight net income position. Our cash reserves are high enough to meet all our budgeted expenses and any unanticipated expenditures.

Rules Committee Report:

Situation: Bases loaded, one out, batter hits an inside-the-park home run. Runner from 3B scores, runner on 2B touches home plate while scoring, the runner on 1B and the batter both score.

Result: The runner who touched home plate is declared "out", but everything that happens after this situation continues. This is considered a "live ball out", and other runners can still be put out on the bases. If the runner who touched home plate had been the third out, all subsequent runs would have been negated.

Old Business:

Public Service Announcement (PSA)

Social Activities (Bar-B-Que/SJ Giants, Holiday Party)

Field Update

Moffett: There is room for improvement related to our use and care of these fields and the facilities. Remember that we are playing as guests and must act accordingly. This includes parking in authorized spaces, warming up in designated places, picking up your trash such as wrappers, cigarette butts, orange and banana peels, not hitting balls against the fences, and just being respectful of all property at the facility. There is a lot of change at Moffett and we need to ensure that we do nothing that might negatively impact our Club and our use of the fields.

Mise: No sunflower seeds, peanuts or chewing gum are allowed. The city is giving us a reduced rate to use this field and we do not want to damage our relationship. Also, we will continue to encounter other groups wanting to use the field during our time period. This will continue throughout the summer. We have the use of the entire field so politely let these other groups know that we will be finished by 1:00pm. We also have allowed them to use the far corners of the field if it does not interfere with our play.

Butcher and Santana: A storage box has been moved to Butcher and is filled with all the gear needed for play on Thursdays. Santana has a new box donated by David Lee. At this time we use Santana as a batting practice field.

All of our fields (except Santana) have an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) located in the storage box. You may familiarize yourself with their operation by reviewing the video on our website. We have not purchase an AED for Santana as it is a BP field only with limited use and because there is a fire station next to the park with emergency responders in house.

Shirts and Caps

We are looking at new vendors to supply our new shirts and caps. The new Vintage logo has multiple colors which increases the cost so we are obtaining bids from various suppliers. We expect to find a supplier and start ordering new clothing during this quarter.

New Business:

Press Release Coverage

The Vintage press release was sent out during the last week of May. Many thanks to Larry Kubo who authored the release and managed its distribution. The release has generated hundreds of "hits", has appeared in the Sunnyvale, Rose Garden and Willow Glen papers, and has resulted in several inquiries about our Club. The release continues to appear in local newspapers after several weeks.

Storage Box at Santana

The storage box at Santana was moved to Butcher Field once we began playing there. Now, Santana once again has a storage box.
