Finally, we are planning our annual San Jose Giants Vintage night- thanks to those who have already provided feedback. We should have final details over the next week.


Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

New Business:

The Board also discussed whether Mondays are a better alternative, as last year on Monday we had slightly better attendance but decided to stay with Wednesday for this season and re-evaluate this fall.

Investing Our Cash

Don Shrank, Barry Schimmel, and Jeff Greenberg evaluated options to put some of our money into a CD and earn interest for the Club. The best option for us was at Keypoint Credit Union, where we will earn \$400+ over the next year. Not a fortune, but better than what we were getting (\$0) and will cover some of our expenses, including using PayPal.

Moffett Field

There were several field maintenance issues that had left Moffett Field unplayable. Working with Bob Bilikas and the NASA/Ames representatives, a plan was developed to fix the problems.

Highlights of the issues at Moffett that were addressed include:

- Fix broken sprinkler/ major hole on field 2
- Several inoperative sprinklers on field 1
- Fix both home plates/strike mats, Jox box on field 2
- Spike infields, then drag (over several days)
- Replace stakes/bases for 2nd base, pitcher's mounds
