Old Business:

Final Fiscal 2018 financials

Our fiscal year ended on September 30, and we had a strong year financially, beating our budget target by \$3700. Our revenues from club dues were on target at about \$20,000, plus we received another \$700 in donations. On the expense side, we were about \$2700 below budget, largely due to needing to buy less supplies (ball, shirts, hats) and some timing issues of bills that got pushed into the next year. We expect that the expenses will catch up this year and have budgeted a breakeven financial performance.

Vintage Shirt Inventory

We received the following shirt order in October: 2 medium full sets of shirts, 16 Large sets, 14 XL sets and 14 XXL sets. We do not anticipate needing any more shirts in 2019.

Softballs

Weekday League is down to four dozen softballs and Saturday is low as well. We will need more softballs in the February-March timeframe.
